

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR FIELDS

- 1) NO PRACTICING ON DAMP OR WET FIELDS.
- 2) NEVER USE BROOMS ON FIELD - IT WILL CREATE LOW SPOTS AND LIPS IN THE FIELD FOR WATER TO LAY AND NOT DRAIN OFF.
- 3) FIELD PREPERATION FOR GAME - A MAXIMUM OF 2 BAGS OF FIELD DRY ARE TO BE USED.
- 4) EVALUATE THE FIELD TO DETERMINE THE WORST SPOTS BEFORE USING FIELD DRY. REMOVE ANY PUDDLES USING PUDDLE PILLOWS. APPLY THE FIELD DRY TO THE AREAS. ALLOW THE FIELD DRY TO SIT MINIMUM OF 20 MINUTES TO BE EFFECTIVE AND REMOVE ANY MOISTURE FROM THE SOIL. THEN BEGIN TO RAKE THOSE AREAS TO BRAKE UP THE CLUMPS OF DIRT.
- 5) AT THE END OF EACH GAME, THE ENTIRE INFIELD IS TO BE RAKED OUT OR ALL AREAS AROUND HOME PLATE, PITCHERS MOUND AND BASE PITS SO THERE WILL BE NO LOW SPOTS IN FIELD FOR WATER TO LAY.
- 6) MANAGERS OR COACHES: IF GANG BOX SUPPLIES ARE RUNNING LOW PLEASE CONTACT FIELD MAINTENANCE DIRECTOR SO THE BOX CAN BE RESTOCKED. PLEASE REMEMBER THAT EVERYONE USES THESE SUPPLIES. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT TILL IT IS EMPTY.
